Applications are invited from retired State/Central/Army Doctors having a graduate allopathic medical degree recognized by AMC and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for 2(two) posts of Medical Officers, one at Postal Dispensary, Jalpaiguri and other at Postal Dispensary, Siliguri on contract basis for a period of 6(six) months which may be extended for another six(6) months or till regular incumbent joins whichever is earlier at a consolidated remuneration of Rs. 13, 125/- per month.

## **Brief terms and conditions for Recruitment of Medical Officers on short term fixed remuneration basis in the Postal Dispensaries.**

1. To provide uninterrupted out door patient care facilities to the P&T employees, the vacant posts of Medical Officers are to be filled up from the retired State/Central Government/Army Doctors only .
2. The Doctors thus considered for appointment shall be recruited for a fixed period or till such time a regular Medical Officer joins.
3. The Medical Officers should be retired state/Central Government/Army Doctor only. No other Medical Officer in any case shall be considered.
4. The Medical Officers should possess a graduate allopathic Medical degree as recognized by the IMC and the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
5. The Medical Officer thus recruited shall be paid a monthly remuneration of Rs. 13,125/- (Rupees thirteen thousand one hundred twenty five) only and shall not be eligible to other allowances such as Non-Practicing Allowance, Contingency Allowance, Post-Graduate Allowance or any other allowance as admissible to the regular incumbents. He/She shall however, be allowed the private practice but strictly not for P&T employees or Pensioners and shall not be required to undergo domiciliary visits.
6. The Doctor should be recruited through an interview by a selection committee after formation of a panel of applicant by local advertisements in the press. The Selection Committee shall comprise of Chief Postmaster General as Chairman with local Postmaster General, Director of postal Services, the concerned Regional Deputy Director General (Medical) and the Local Medical Officer Incharge as members.
7. Where the vacancy is for a period of less than one month time, the Head of the Circle may decide the remuneration proportion to the days of the vacancy compared with total remuneration of Rs. 13125/- per month.
8. The fixed remuneration contract basis Medical Officers appointed shall be allowed only a day's Casual leave for every 30 days period of service and no encashment sll be allowed. The leave due shall be calculated for each short term contract and no carry forward of leave will be allowed. In case of absence from duty, proportionate deductions may be made from the short term Medical Officer's remuneration.
9. GPF contribution/DTC/CGEIS/reimbursement of medical facilities and accommodation etc shall not be allowed to such Medical Officers.
10. The Department can terminate the contract even before the expiry of the fixed term in the event of a regular Medical Officer joining or if the services of the Medical Officer not found to be satisfactory and no claims for the remuneration for the remaining contract period shall be entertained.
11. The services of the adhoc Medical Officers thus recruited be desired for 6 hours for the weekdays and as per the previous arrangement on the holidays. The timings of service shall be as per the local timings of the dispensaries.
