Division level sorting competition	6 <sup>th</sup> & 7 <sup>th</sup> Sept.2010
Circle Level Sorting Competition	4 <sup>th</sup> & 5 <sup>th</sup> Oct.2010
All India Competition	11 <sup>th</sup> Nov. 2010

The theme for introduction of this sorting competition is to encourage Sorting Assistants to develop proficiency in sorting both in terms of speed and accuracy by memorizing local TD, Head Offices of all the Circles and all India Pin Code to minimize the mis-sending to the extent. Attractive prizes in form of gold coin and foreign tour will be awarded besides a certificate signed by Secretary (Posts) to the winners.
