Based on the clarifications sought by various PSBs, we hereby provide our responses to the same.

No	Clarification sought	Response from IPPB
1	Is there going to be an extension to the deadline?	The deadline for application has been extended to 19 th October, 2016.
2	What are the Pay and Allowances for the Posts on deputation?	<p>IPPB's Pay Scales are likely to be same as that of Public Sector Banks. The likely various allowances and benefits are as under:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. DA, CCA, Fixed Personal Pay and Special Pay in line with 10th bipartite agreement of PSBs ii. HRA / Housing Allowance in line with State Banks iii. Other general allowances and benefits: up to 50% of Basic as a bouquet of Allowances <p>If the individual retains Parent organisation's Pay and Allowances, then deputation allowance will be paid.</p>
3	Can a candidate apply for more than one post?	No. Each candidate can apply for only one post.
4	What are the available posts on deputation?	<p>The list of available posts can be found in "Annexure I – Summary of Available Posts to be filled up on deputation". This Annexure has been circulated to all PSBs and can also be found on the website – www.indiapost.gov.in</p> <p>It is to be noted that the list of posts called on deputation currently are for roles at the Corporate Office only and is part of Phase I of this exercise.</p> <p>As part of Phase II & III, India Post Payments Bank Limited will also seek for applications for posts on deputation at the Central Processing Centre and at the various District level Branches.</p>
