8. Criteria for selection:

- a. Candidates qualifying in Stage-I shall be eligible to appear for test in Stage-II.
- b. Only such candidates who qualify in each paper of Stage-II shall be considered for preparation of final merit list.
- c. Final merit list of the qualified candidates shall be prepared on the basis of total marks secured by the candidates in both the stage of examination.
- d. After arranging the candidates in order of merit as per (c) above, number of candidates to be declared successful shall be equal to the number of vacancies in each category.

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e. In the event of any vacancy notified for recruitment remains unfilled due to non-joining of selected candidates, the next candidate in the merit list shall be considered for appointment. However, appointment of such candidate shall be only on refusal / declining offer of appointment and no wait list or approved panel shall be maintained.

Note: The date and venue of the tests will be intimated separately to the eligible candidates. No intimation will be sent in respect of other applicants who are not eligible.

9. Disqualification: No Person

- a. Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

10.Disclaimer:

- a. The Department of Posts reserves the right to cancel this recruitment process without assigning any reason.
- b. The vacancies notified are subject to change without assigning any reasons and Department reserves the right to cancel the recruitment.

11.Special instructions to the candidates

- a. The candidates should fill up all the fields of the application formas enclosed Annexure-I. The form should be downloaded from India post website or MP Post website. Application purchased from outside vendors will not be accepted and summarily rejected without assigning any reason.
- b. Incomplete application form will be summarily rejected.
- c. No column should be left blank
- d. One envelope should contain one application only.
- e. Along with the application form an Indian Postal Order For Rs.100/- from any Post Office should be enclosed as application fee. Women candidates and candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Ex-servicemen (ESM) eligible for reservation are exempted from payment of fee.
