Message from the Minister of Communications

Namaskar!

The past year has unfolded as a magnificent odyssey for India Post, a radiant testament to our steadfast dedication to envelop every corner of Bharat with trust, ingenuity, and unwavering pride. Inspired by the sagacious leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji, the Department of Posts has strengthened its reach, modernised its systems, and renewed its commitment to deliver trust and opportunity to every citizen of Bharat.

A pivotal milestone dawned with the Post Office Act, 2023, infusing fresh vitality into our cherished postal legacy as it took effect on 18 June 2024, with Rules and Regulations proclaimed by 16 December 2024. This transformative reform laid the foundation for the nationwide unveiling of the Advanced Postal Technology (APT) platform on 4 August 2025. Forged indigenously by CEPT and cradled on the MeghRaj 2.0 Cloud, APT introduces QR-code payments, OTP-enabled delivery, and DIGIPIN integration to every threshold. With over four lakh devoted employees meticulously trained, we are sculpting a future where technology stands as a luminous bridge to progress.

At the core of our mission beats the pulse of financial inclusion. The Post Office Savings Bank (POSB) tenderly nurtures 36.56 crore accounts, safeguarding a treasure of ₹21.29 lakh crore in deposits as of 31 August 2025, a 14 percent growth that mirrors the deep trust of our people. The India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) has blossomed gloriously, embracing 12.43 crore customers a 41 percent surge through 1.65 lakh access points, with deposits soaring 85 percent to ₹21,307 crore and ₹34,878 crore disbursed via 11.67 crore AePS transactions. The addition of 108 new access points in the North East, adorned with the Digital Payments Award 2024–25, heralds our leadership. The Sukanya Samridhi Yojana, with 3.64 crore accounts 84 percent through Post Offices welcomed 41 lakh new savers between March 2024 and August 2025, while Postal Life Insurance (PLI) and Rural Postal Life Insurance (RPLI) uphold 1.19 crore policies with a ₹1.85 lakh crore corpus, their premium income flourishing by 15.6 percent to ₹18,782 crore in FY 2024–25.

The Department of Posts (DoP) has unveiled a significant enhancement to its Speed Post services, introducing revised tariffs effective from October 1, 2025, alongside a suite of innovative features designed to elevate its stature as India's preferred delivery service. These updates include OTP-based delivery for heightened security, real-time tracking for seamless visibility, and online booking for unmatched convenience. Crafted with a vision to bolster reliability, safeguard customers, and enrich their experience, these advancements reflect DoP's unwavering commitment to delivering excellence across the nation.

Our logistics network has blossomed into a vibrant ecosystem, with 188 Parcel Hubs, 234 Nodal Delivery Centres, and 1,860 Packaging Units weaving a resilient framework. The 86 National Routes, stretching 60,000 kilometres daily, link over 400 cities in harmony, while our Amazon partnership in the North East delivered 1.07 lakh parcels, yielding ₹90.88 lakh. Citizen services gleam brightly through 450 Post Office Passport Seva Kendras processing 1.85 crore applications for ₹667 crore, and 13,352 Aadhaar Centres managing 13.23 crore transactions, a 37.96 percent rise for ₹608.08 crore. In the distant reaches of Chhattisgarh, 236 new Branch Post Offices kindle hope, while Dak Chaupals, now 67,888 strong with a 420.65 percent surge, have embraced 43.19 lakh lives, 45 percent women.

Direct Benefit Transfers have cascaded like a lifeline, channeling ₹90,941.13 crore to 10.5 crore beneficiaries. Gyan Post, launched on 1 May 2025, and Dak Ghar Niryat Kendras, with 1,013 units handling 11.27 lakh shipments valued at ₹262.98 crore, a 192.20 percent growth, unlock gateways to knowledge and trade. Rozgar Mela welcomed 1,47,569 new colleagues (1,30,486 GDS, 17,083 DR) from 1,80,985 offers by 17 September 2025, while Dak Karmayogi e-Learning has engaged 5.02 lakh employees for 1.02 crore courses, a 328.75 percent leap. Our Jan Bhagidari efforts, from 13,934 Post Offices in Har Ghar Tiranga to 6.95 crore voter messages, bind us in a shared tapestry of national pride.

Each of these triumphs embodies the soul of Dak Seva, Jan Seva-service that reaches every hamlet and touches every heart. As we stride toward Viksit Bharat @2047, let us advance with pride, purpose, and an unshakable faith that every letter delivered and every citizen uplifted draws us closer to a more empowered Bharat.

NATIONAL POSTAL WEEK

On World Post Day 2025, Ms. Vandita Kaul, Secretary, Department of Posts, extended her greetings to all. Her message highlighted new initiatives in postal services and reflected the reliability and dedication of India Post in serving the nation.



Every year, National Postal Week is observed around World Post Day (9th October 2025), which marks the anniversary of the establishment of the Universal Postal Union (UPU) in 1874. The Department of Posts celebrated National Postal Week from 6th to 10th October, 2025. This week is dedicated to spreading awareness about the services of India Post, while also highlighting its achievements, technological advancements, and the inspiring human stories that connect the department with the people.

The purpose of World Post Day is to raise awareness about the vital role of postal services in people's daily lives and businesses, and their significant contribution to social and economic development worldwide. As part of the National Postal Week celebrations, camps promoting financial inclusion were organized on 7th October 2025, across various regions. These camps, aimed to spread awareness about savings schemes and empower rural communities through financial literacy. Additionally, Dak Chaupals were conducted in every Sub Division and Head Office.

India Post Charts the Road Ahead at Business Meet 2025-26 (Q2)



In the presence Secretary (Posts), Members of the Postal Services Board, and all 23 Chief Postmasters General (CPMGs), Hon'ble Union Minister of Communications and DoNER, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, announced the results of India Post's second quarter for FY 2025–26 at the Business Meet 2025–26 (Q2) held in New Delhi.

Achieving 80% of the Q2 target and 38% of the annual target in H1, India Post continues its upward trajectory, driven by the collective leadership and commitment of its CPMGs. The momentum built in Q2 reflects the synergy and determination of the department, setting the stage for even greater milestones in the months ahead.

Press Brief: Key Achievements of the Department of Posts



Union Minister of Communications and Development of North Eastern Region, Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, chaired a joint media briefing at the National Media Center, New Delhi, highlighting the achievements of the

Department of Posts (DoP) and the Department of Telecommunications over the past year. The media brief was attended by Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications and Rural Development, Dr. Chandra Sekhar Pemmasani, Secretary (Posts), Ms Vandita Kaul and other dignitaries.

Under the vision of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, Shri Scindia underscored the remarkable transformation of the Department of Posts from a traditional postal network to a citizen-centric logistics and digital services organisation, combining trust, technology, and inclusion to serve every Indian household.

Embracing Atmanirbhar Bharat, the Department is driving digital transformation through the in-house IT 2.0 project developed indigenously at Center for Excellence in Postal Technology (CEPT). Strengthening its logistics ecosystem, India Post has also partnered with leading e-commerce companies for enhancing customer engagement via a revamped Customer Relationship Management (CRM) platform.

The Department is going to introduce new services, including domestic 24/48 Speed Post, Parcel Next Day Delivery, Parcel E2E, and international options such as Direct Line, Speed Post International, and Parcel Last Mile, aimed at enhancing global delivery and export support.

The Department is also introducing DIGIPIN, a digital address ecosystem mapping India into 4m x 4m grids with unique 10-character codes, enabling citizen-centric service delivery, digital KYC, emergency response, and strengthening geospatial governance.

Through logistics reform, digital innovation, and inclusive growth, the Department of Posts continues to redefine itself as a key enabler of Viksit Bharat.

Speed Post: Faster, Safer, Smarter

To further strengthen its position as the preferred delivery service, Speed Post has now been upgraded with the following features aimed at enhancing reliability, security, and convenience:

- OTP-based secure delivery
- Online payment facility
- SMS-based delivery notifications
- Convenient online booking services
- Real-time delivery updates
- Registration facility for users

Registration is also available as a value-added service for both documents and parcels. Customers can have addressee-specific secured delivery for ₹5/- per item (plus GST), delivered only to the addressee or an authorised person.

These initiatives are part of India Post's ongoing journey to evolve into a more secure, transparent, and technology-enabled service provider.

India Post Resumed International Postal Services to the USA



The Department of Posts resumed all categories of international postal services to the USA from 15 October 2025. Services had been suspended on 22 August 2025 due to new U.S. Customs regulations. After extensive system development and successful trials, India Post established a compliant Delivery Duty Paid (DDP) mechanism, under which customs duties are collected in India and remitted directly to U.S. Customs. This initiative enables MSMEs, artisans, and exporters to continue using an affordable, fully compliant, and reliable channel for shipments to the USA.

India Post Enables Doorstep Delivery of Medicines for Ex-Servicemen

The Department of Posts (DoP), in collaboration with Department of Ex-servicemen (DESW), has launched a dedicated service to facilitate the pickup, booking, transmission, and doorstep delivery of medicines that are not available at ECHS polyclinics under Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS).

Under this initiative, medicines will be procured and packaged through Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) Common Service Centre (CSC) stationed at ECHS polyclinics, while logistics and delivery will be managed by India Post's trusted delivery network. This arrangement ensures that medicines reach ECHS beneficiaries efficiently, securely, and across all corners of the country.

Special campaign 5.0



Fostering Cyber Hygiene at Workplace

As part of National Cyber Security Awareness Month 2025, under Special Campaign 5.0, a seminar on 'Cyber Hygiene' was held on 15th October 2025 at the G.P. Roy Committee Room, Dak Bhawan, New Delhi. 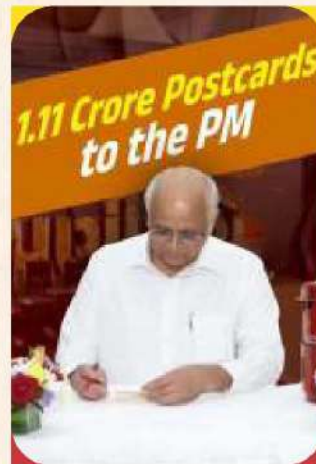

Philately Corner: Stamps & Stories



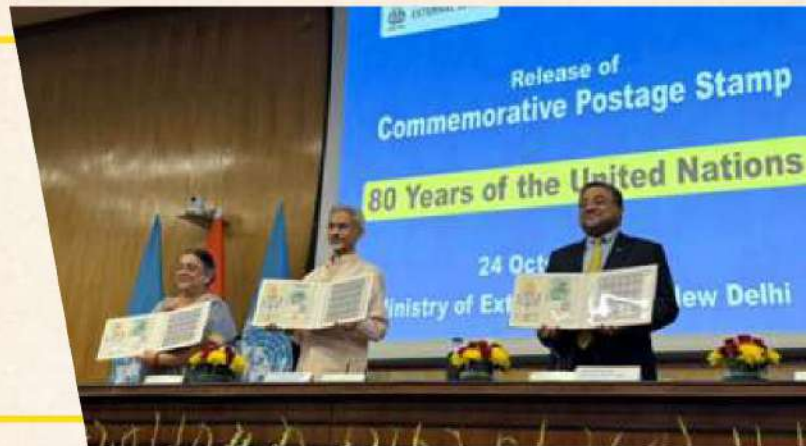

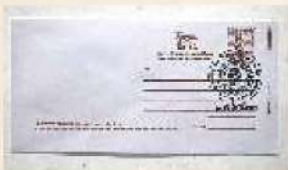
