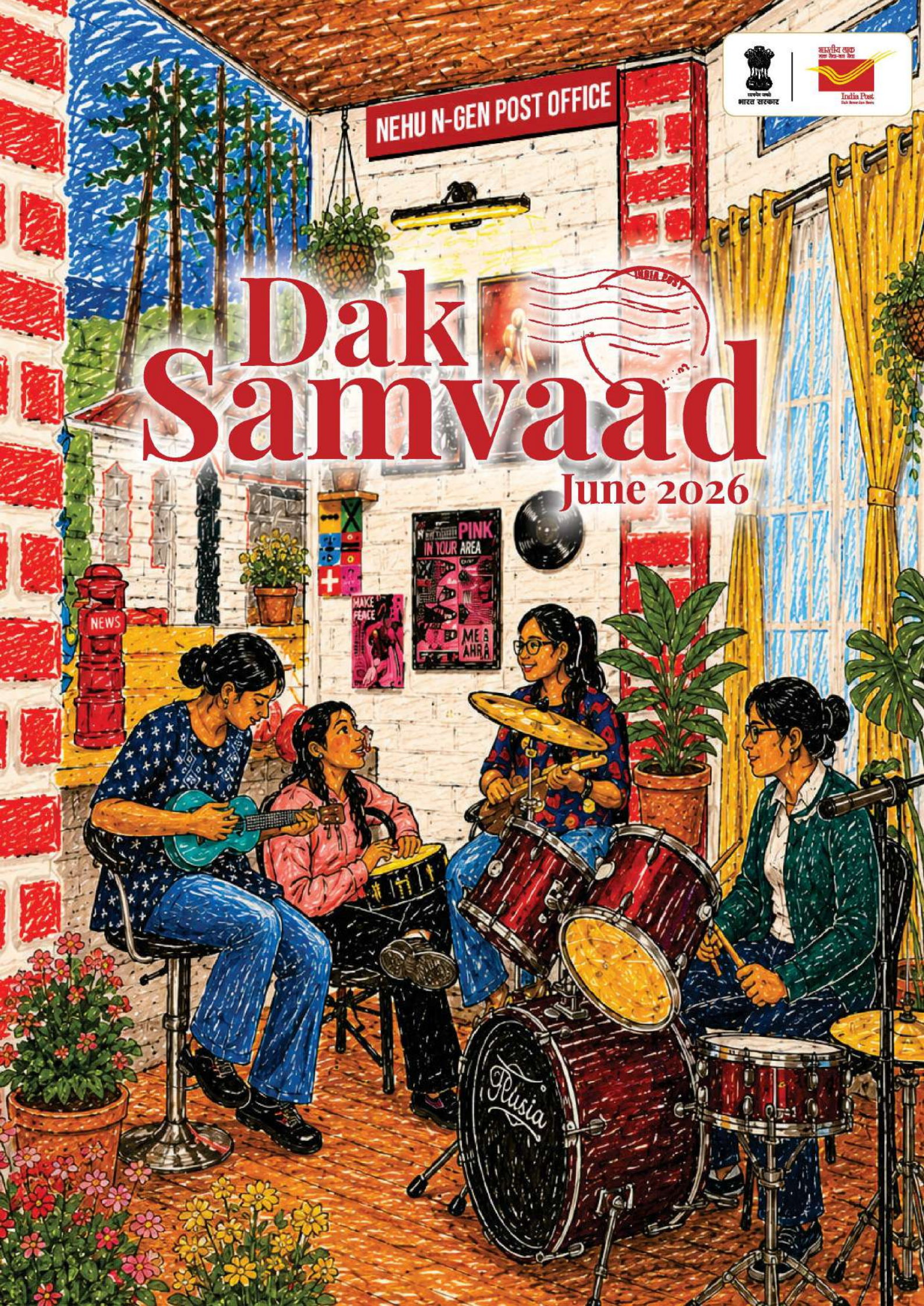




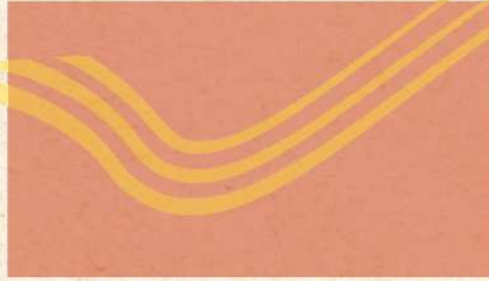

Jan Sewa Connect: Modernising Post Offices



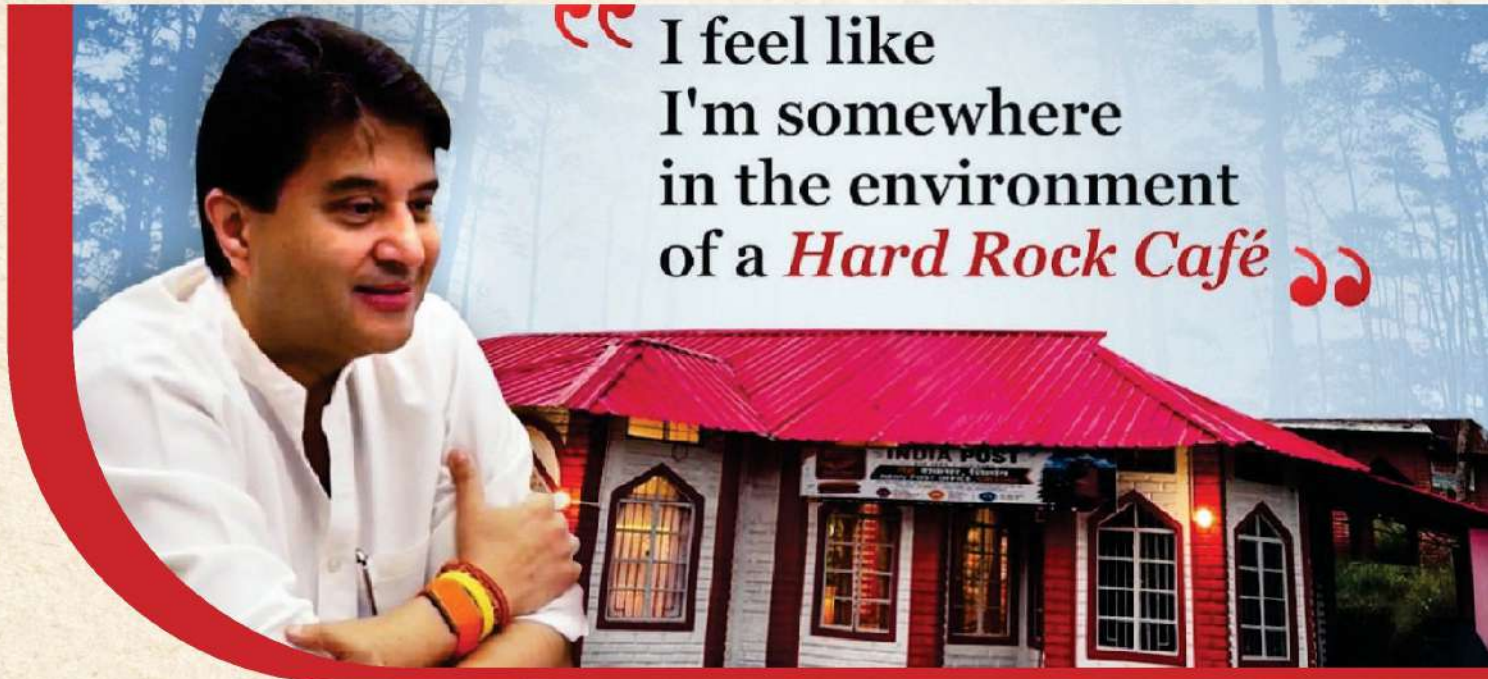
Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, Hon'ble Minister for Communications, along with Smt. Rekha Gupta, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi, and Dr. Chandra Sekhar Pemmasani, Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications, dedicated the renovated Nehru Place Post Office to the public in New Delhi on 7th May 2026. The event was also attended by Smt. Vandita Kaul, Secretary (Posts); Shri Jitendra Gupta, Director General Postal Services, Col. Akhilesh Pandey, Chief Postmaster

General, Delhi Circle and other senior officers of the Department. The upgraded Post Office is the first site under the Department's nationwide modernization initiative, being implemented as a Proof of Concept. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Scindia underlined the Department's ongoing digital transformation, including UPI-enabled services, OTP-based delivery, extended-hour Post Offices and time-bound delivery services such as 24 Speed Post and 48 Speed Post. Delhi Chief Minister Smt. Rekha Gupta appreciated the transformation of India Post into a modern multi-service public institution offering banking, Aadhaar, passport, insurance and digital services under one roof.

Taking forward the same vision, Shri Scindia and Shri Devendra Fadnavis, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra, inaugurated the renovated Andheri Railway Station Post Office in Mumbai on 8th May 2026 under Jan Sewa Connect. Originally established in 1932-33, the Andheri RS Post Office is the first in Maharashtra and the second in the country to be inaugurated under the initiative. The upgraded facility has been transformed into a future-ready, customer-centric and technology-enabled service hub with modern interiors, improved customer amenities, digital integration and strengthened branding. Both renovated Post Offices reflect the Department's vision of transforming traditional Post Offices into accessible, efficient and digitally empowered centres of Jan Sewa Connect. With modern infrastructure, improved public spaces, modular service counters, barrier-free access and digitally integrated service zones, the initiative seeks to create a seamless and welcoming experience for citizens.

In another inspiring interaction, the Hon'ble Minister met Shri Yogendra Kushwah, ABPM, Nepari B.O., Madhya Pradesh Circle, and appreciated his dedication, fitness journey and positive presence on social media. During the interaction, he underlined the importance of health and fitness, and said that such inspiration should reach not only the postal family but also the youth of the country. Shri Yogendra shared that the support of the Department of Posts has played an important role in helping him pursue his goals. Alongside his postal responsibilities, he has built a strong presence as a fitness model and social media influencer.

India Post's Growth and Transformation Journey

Dr. Chandra Sekhar Pemmasani, Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications, in an interview with DD India, highlighted India Post's remarkable transformation, with revenue rising to ₹15,373 crore in FY 2025-26, marking one of the most significant financial milestones in the Department's 170-year history. He noted that the Department achieved an unprecedented single-year revenue



increase of ₹2,100 crore. Dr. Pemmasani also stated that the parcel and logistics segment registered 70% growth, driven by technology integration and expanded e-commerce partnerships. A cornerstone of the Department's modernisation drive is the ₹5,800 crore investment under the Advanced Postal Technology initiative as part of IT 2.0. The Minister of State outlined the Department's vision of fully digital, end-to-end services, enabling citizens to purchase savings and insurance products, download digital certificates, and receive maturity payments directly into their bank accounts without visiting a Post Office. Through India Post Payments Bank, the Department is currently distributing approximately ₹45,000 crore annually through Direct Benefit Transfer, making it one of the largest last-mile welfare delivery channels in the country. He further underlined India Post's focus on financial inclusion through women-centric savings products, Self-Help Group linkages and rural savings accounts, supported by the extensive Gramin Dak Sevak network.

Strengthening India Post's Digital and Global Commerce Capabilities



On 7th May 2026, Dr. Chandra Sekhar Pemmasani, Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications, held discussions on leveraging India Post's extensive network to support international trade and e-commerce. The deliberations focused on connecting local businesses, particularly those in remote areas, with global markets through digital platforms and postal infrastructure. The discussion highlighted India Post's growing role in addressing last-

mile connectivity challenges and enabling small and homegrown enterprises to access customers worldwide, strengthening its position as a gateway for global commerce.



Taking forward the Department's digital transformation agenda, the Minister reviewed the progress of APT 2.0 on 12th May 2026. APT 2.0 is India Post's technology platform aimed at modernising postal services across the country by integrating banking, insurance and mail services through a unified digital infrastructure. Leveraging AI and real-time data, and developed using indigenous technology, the platform is

expected to enhance the speed, reliability and responsiveness of India Post's services for citizens across urban and rural areas.

UPU Innovation Challenge 2026

Ms. Vandita Kaul, Secretary (Posts), attended the UPU Innovation Challenge 2026 at RAKNPA (Rafi Ahmed Kidwai National Postal Academy), Ghaziabad, and addressed the participants. In her remarks, she highlighted the important role of postal networks in supporting communities during climate-related disruptions and emergencies. She also emphasised the growing significance of technology, AI-enabled systems, geospatial innovation and international collaboration in strengthening postal networks and enhancing public service delivery.



Workshop on UPI Integration with UPU Postal Framework



A workshop on the integration of UPI with the UPU International Postal Framework was organised to advance secure, real-time and inclusive digital remittance solutions. The programme brought together postal administrations, international organisations and key stakeholders to strengthen collaboration in cross-border financial services. Held from 19th-21st May 2026, the workshop witnessed participation from delegates representing multiple countries, both in person and virtually, marking another significant step towards building a more connected global postal financial ecosystem.

Director General Postal Services Visits Chhattisgarh Circle



Shri Jitendra Gupta, Director General Postal Services, visited Chhattisgarh Postal Circle on 14th May 2026 and chaired a review meeting in the presence of Shri Ajay Singh Chauhan, Chief Postmaster General, Assistant Directors, Divisional Heads and other officials. The meeting focused on the services and products of the Department, targets, citizen-centric initiatives, insurance schemes and measures to strengthen overall functioning. The Director General provided valuable guidance and necessary directions for effective achievement of organisational goals.



As part of the visit, another review meeting was held on 15th May 2026 at Jagdalpur in the remote Bastar Division under the guidance of the Director General Postal Services. The meeting was attended by the Chief Postmaster General, Chhattisgarh Circle, along with senior officers and a large number of Gramin Dak Sevaks. Discussions centred around the mantra of "Service, Trust and Achievement of Targets", with

special emphasis on expanding Postal Life

Insurance, Rural Postal Life Insurance and Small Savings Schemes in rural and remote areas, along with enhancing customer communication and last-mile service delivery.

India Post & Flipkart Partnership



In a major step towards strengthening India's e-commerce logistics ecosystem and enhancing last mile delivery capabilities across the country, the Department of Posts (DoP), Ministry of Communications and Flipkart India Private Limited have signed an Agreement for Last Mile Parcel Delivery Services.

The Agreement was signed on 22nd

May 2026 in New Delhi by Shri Neeraj Kumar Jha, General Manager, Parcel Directorate, Department of Posts, and Shri Harvinder Kapur, Director - Commercial, Flipkart India Private Limited, in the presence of Shri Adnan Ahmed, Chief General Manager, Parcel and CCS Directorate, Department of Posts, Shri Dippy Vankani- Director (Corporate Affairs), Flipkart India Private Limited and other senior officers from both organizations. Under the Agreement, the Department of Posts will provide last-mile delivery services for Flipkart shipments across India, leveraging its vast network of over 1.6 lakh Post Offices and trusted delivery presence across urban, semi-urban, rural and remote areas. The services will include delivery of prepaid and COD parcels, OTP-based delivery authentication and real-time shipment tracking. The partnership is expected to enhance delivery efficiency, improve customer experience, expand serviceability in remote and rural locations, and strengthen logistics support for India's growing e-commerce sector.

World Philately Expo 2026

India Post participated in the World Philately Expo 2026 in Boston, showcasing the country's rich philatelic heritage and cultural legacy before a global audience. The participation brought alive the role of postage stamps in preserving stories of India's history, art, culture and national identity.

Celebrating the universal language of music, India Post released a Special Cover at the Expo on 25th May 2026. The cover

captured the power of music to connect people across borders, cultures and generations. The India Post pavilion was visited by Shri Raghuram Sastry, Consul General of India, and Ms. Shruthi Purushotam, Deputy Consul General, who appreciated the rich legacy of Indian stamps and philately. Through its participation, India Post reaffirmed the timeless role of philately in connecting nations through heritage, creativity and communication.

In the remote village of Tural in Ratnagiri, Maharashtra, Smt. Their journey shows how India Post's last mile network is helping small businesses, rural entrepreneurs and homegrown brands reach wider markets.

Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India released a commemorative postage stamp on 12th May 2026 dedicated to Somnath Temple, marking 1,000 years of spiritual continuity, resilience and civilisational significance. The First Album of the stamp was presented to the Hon'ble Prime Minister by Shri Ganesh Sawaleshwarakar, Chief Postmaster General, Gujarat Circle.

Revered as the first among the 12 Jyotirlingas of Mahadev, Somnath has remained a timeless symbol of devotion, rising again through centuries of destruction and reconstruction. Situated on India's western coast, the temple has long stood at the confluence of faith, pilgrimage and maritime cultural exchange.

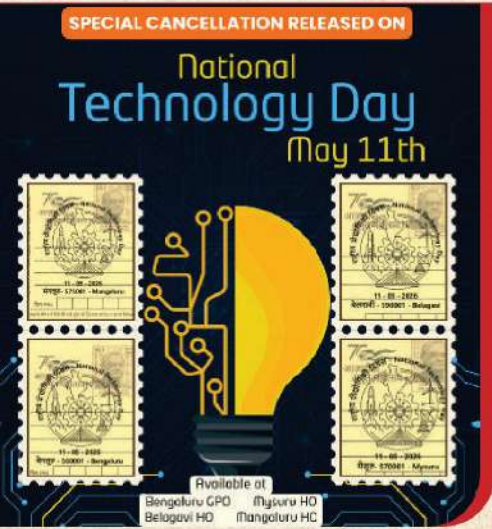
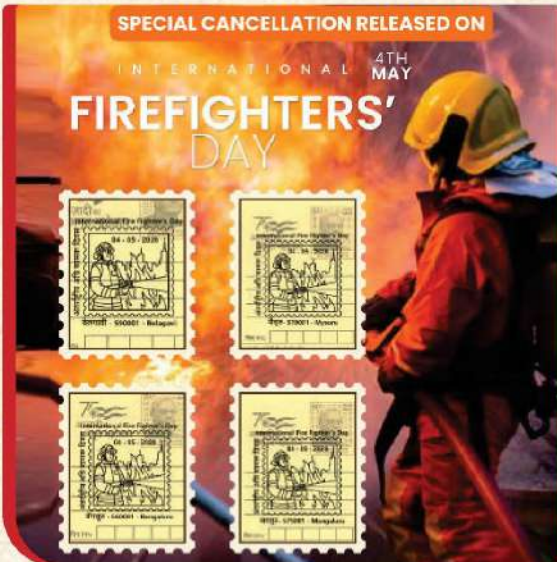
