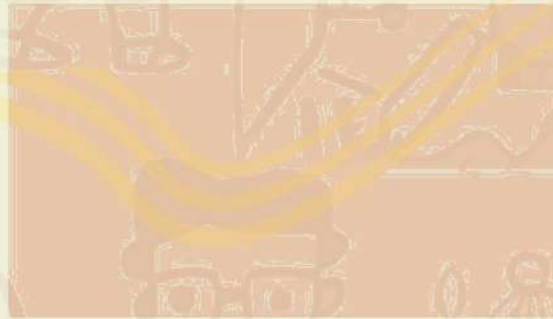

## IMS Workshop: Modernising Postal Insurance

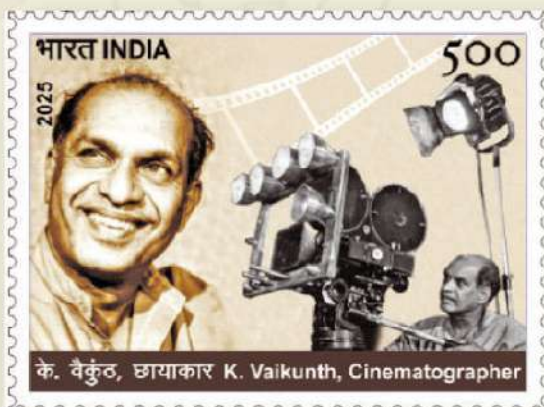

## IPPB Signs MoU with EPFO for Doorstep Digital Life Certificate Services

India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) has signed an MoU with the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) to provide free doorstep Digital Life Certificate (DLC) services to EPFO pensioners under EPS'95. The MoU was exchanged between Shri R. Viswesvaran, MD & CEO, IPPB, and Shri Ramesh Krishnamurthi, CPFC, EPFO, during the 73rd Foundation Day of EPFO, in the presence of Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Labour & Employment and Youth Affairs & Sports, Ms. Vandana Gurnani, Secretary (Labour and Employment), Members of CBT, and senior officers of MoLE, EPFO and IPPB.



IPPB will leverage its vast network of 1.65 lakh Post Offices and 3 lakh+ Postmen/GDS equipped with doorstep devices, enabling pensioners to submit their DLCs from home using Face Authentication or Fingerprint biometrics. India Post has also been running a nationwide campaign to promote DLC services among pensioners, providing doorstep assistance to ensure timely and hassle-free submission.

The initiative supports the Government's Digital India and Ease of Living vision, ensuring hassle-free, dignified services for senior citizens.

## Strengthening Healthcare: India Post Signs MoU with NHM Jharkhand

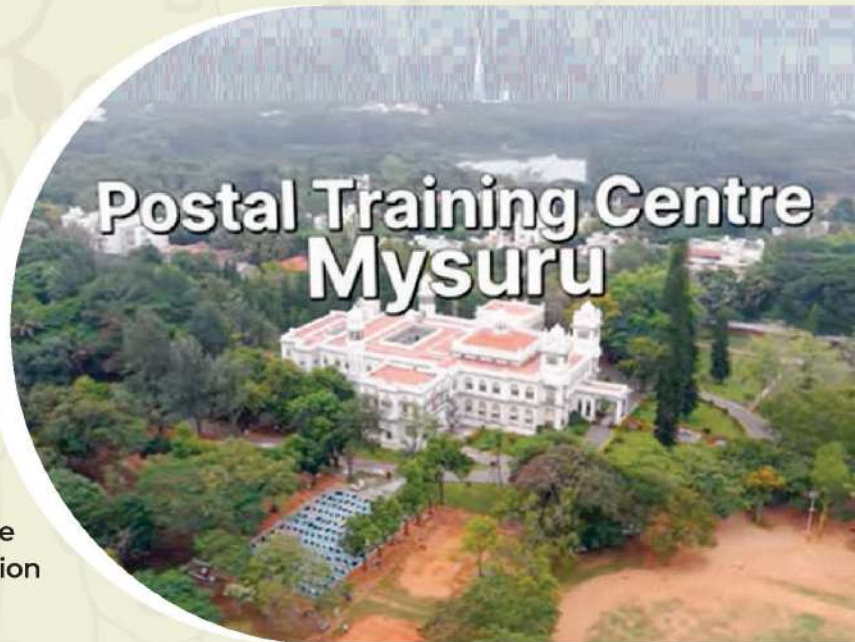
